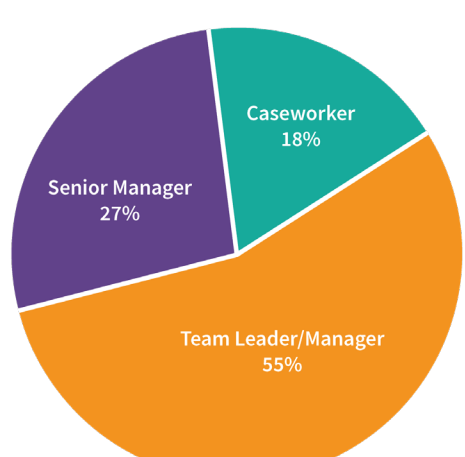
Upcoming Legal Webinars
