The training is free and consists of 3 training modules. The modules cover the ACMP, the role of caseworkers, and key practice approaches. [Click to enrol.](#)

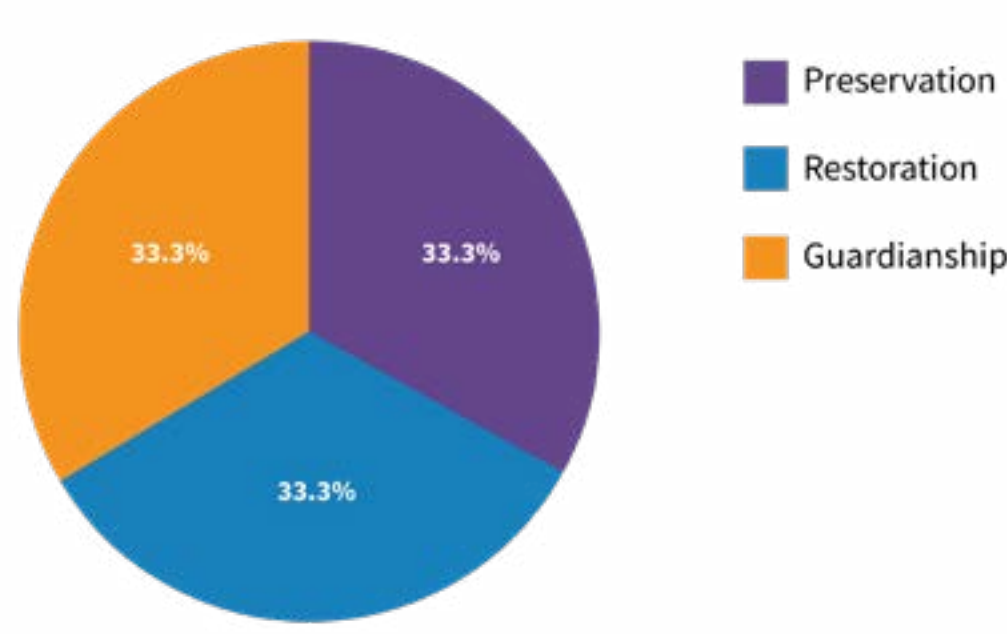
Responding to trauma
