PSP Learning Hub Extension to 2024

We're excited to let you know that the PSP Learning Hub has been extended for another two years until June 2024.

The PSP Learning Hub will continue to deliver training and resources to help support your core work with children, families and communities. This will tie-in with the existing training and support that you receive from your agencies.

The Hub will increase support to help all achieve permanency outcomes for children and young people. This will include bi-monthly manager's groups to unpack, share and learn what it is to be a champion for permanency. The manager groups will explore the concept of permanency and how to help teams achieve permanency for children and young people, through Practice Working Groups, live webinars, coaching and Communities of Practice. We're going to help promote a culture that prioritises permanency and supports you to overcome barriers.

As always, your feedback is essential. Curijo will consult with you, through Practice Advisory and Working Groups, as well as RIGs and DIGs, about what is working for you, and what they can improve, to make sure they are hitting the mark.
